JERRY CRAFT

Child of America Honoree

Jerry Craft taught graphic arts and writing to Carver kids for more than 10 years at the Carver Community Center. Jerry is an American cartoonist and children's book illustrator best known for his syndicated newspaper comic strip Mama's Boyz and his graphic novel New Kid.

Jerry is one of only a handful of syndicated African American cartoonists in the US. Jerry is the New York Times bestselling author and illustrator of the graphic novels New Kid and Class Act.

New Kid is the only book in history to win the John Newbery Medal for the most outstanding contribution to children's literature (2020), the Kirkus Prize for Young Readers' Literature (2019), and the Coretta Scott King Author Award for the most outstanding work by an African American writer (2020).

Despite attempts by lawmakers and some parents to remove his books from Texas schools, Jerry's books have actually gotten more attention thanks to the controversies. The director Prentice Penny, LeBron James' SpringHill, and Universal are teaming up to bring Jerry's New Kid to the big screen!



ROBBIE GORDY

Gala Auctioneer

Robbie Gordy is an Associate Vice President and Auctioneer at Christie's New York, where he works on the development and presentation of the auction house's most prestigious and high-profile consignments.

Robbie's work includes the notable collections of gallerists Ileana Sonnabend and Nina Castelli Sundell; London art dealer Leslie Waddington; President and Mrs. Ronald Reagan; groundbreaking Asian art dealer Robert Hatfield Ellsworth; legendary comedian Joan Rivers; financiers and businessmen such as John C.Whitehead and Edgar M. Bronfman; and the landmark sale of the estate of David Rockefeller.

A Fulbright Scholar and graduate of London's Courtauld Institute of Art, Robbie studied nineteenth-century European painting and sculpture, as well as international Modern and Contemporary art, before joining Christie's London salerooms.

In addition to auctioneering Christie's sales, Robbie is an enthusiastic Charity Auctioneer who works with many leading philanthropic, civic, and cultural organizations across the United States.
